Week 4 of Elmer's Great North Parade celebrates Arts, Music and Culture. What is the title of the song which features in the design of 'Faith'?

## 8 Pet's Corner, Jesmond Dene

The Elmer books often focus on the environment and sustainability, and many of our little Elmers do too! Can you name 3 of the plastic wrappers which make up the fur of little sculpture, 'Drastic Plastic: A Mammoth Issue'?

## 9 Fenwick Toy Department, Newcastle

What famous half marathon is shown on large sculpture, 'Run North East'? Hint: In 2018, this event helped St Oswald's Hospice to fundraise over £160,000.

Can you name the four elements which feature in the design of 'Eco Elmer'?



## 11 Eldon Leisure, Newcastle
