Haiku are simple and satisfying ways of expressing an observation.

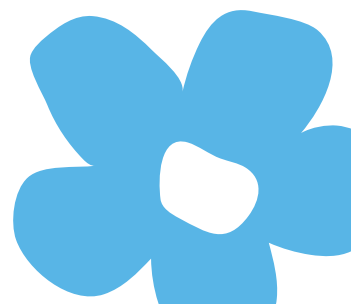
A haiku consists of three lines with a total of 17 syllables.
