

## Terms & Conditions

These Terms and Conditions are the Raffle Rules. By entering the raffle, entrants agree to be bound by these rules.

Thank you for supporting St Oswald's Hospice Super Shaun Raffle. The closing date is Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2023 and the draw will take place on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> October 2023. Any money received after the closing date will be treated as a donation. Cheques to be made payable to St Oswald's Hospice Promotions LTD. Please be aware that credit card payments will not be accepted online or over the phone.

No tickets may be sold to under 16s and the maximum number of tickets which can be purchased is 200 per person. If any ticket/s are unknowingly sold to a person who is under the age of 16, they will be exempt from the raffle, they will forfeit their prize and their entry money will be returned to them.

All tickets shall be priced at £1.

All raffle entry sales are final and no refunds shall be made at any time. All entrants acknowledge that their payment of £1 per ticket to enter the Super Shaun Raffle does not guarantee that they will win any prize.

Full payment for each ticket must be received either in the form of cash or cleared funds before the ticket can be entered into the draw. Only tickets for which full payment has been received either in the form of cash or cleared funds are eligible to win the prize.

Winners will be notified by telephone, email or post no later than two weeks after the draw date. In the event that an entrant changes their contact details, they will be solely responsible for advising St Oswald's Hospice Promotions Ltd of the change.

Winners will be selected by St Oswald's Hospice Promotions Ltd drawn from a traditional mean of all physical tickets in a container. The results of the draw are final.

St Oswald's Hospice Promotions Ltd reserves the right to disqualify any entrant if it has reasonable grounds to believe the entrant has breached any of these rules.

**Proceeds and prizes:** Based on a previous similar raffle, £9630 was made in ticket sales. 94.8% of this went to support the charity, St Oswald's Hospice, 0% was spent on prizes as this was free of charge and 5.2% was spent on production expenses (e.g. ticket printing and promotion.)

With 9630 tickets sold and 1 prize to be won, each ticket had a 0.01% chance of winning a prize. Your chances of winning a prize in the Super Shaun Raffle will depend on the number of entries in the draw.

In the Super Shaun Raffle one prize is available which is a medium sized Shaun the Sheep Sculpture. It is the same as the sculptures created by Wild in Art, in partnership with Aardman, designed and created for the Shaun the Sheep on the Tyne art trail, in support of St Oswald's Hospice and used for the Little Shaun trail of designs painted by schools.

The sculpture measurements are:

Height – 674mm Length – 738mm Width – 369mm
