St Oswald' Hospice Outpatient Clinic for **Young Adults**

This service is for young people aged 16-35+ who have grown up with and are living with serious or complex health conditions.

The clinic offers advice and support to patients and their carers, working closely with the other health and care teams around the patient to ensure continuity of care and address unmet needs.

Background

St Oswald's outpatient service for young adults was first set up in 2018 as a pilot transition clinic for young people with neurodisability. The pilot identified unmet needs and gaps in service that extended beyond transition, and so the remit of the young adult clinic was extended.

What we do

- Holistic assessment to identify and address unmet needs and facilitate patient-centred goal-setting.
- Emergency care planning to ensure appropriate response to health crises.
- Coordination of care across different settings alongside GP and specialist teams.
- Time for family carers to share their concerns.
- Support for patient and family when health is deteriorating or end of life care is needed.
- Advice and teaching for health professionals.

About the service

Clinic reviews will normally be held at St Oswald's Hospice or through remote consultations. Visits at home or another location can also be arranged, and we are always happy to attend joint consultations with other healthcare professionals.

Dr Jo Elverson leads the clinic. She is a palliative care consultant with special interests in transition, neurodisability and learning disability. The St Oswald's multidisciplinary team support the clinic and are happy to review patients or give advice as needed.

We aim to work closely with other health care professionals to maintain continuity of care. In addition to in writing, if there are complex problems, we may wish to speak directly or arrange a meeting of the professionals supporting the patient.
