#### Aims

To help the Communications and Marketing team to promote our events, projects and services in an engaging and effective way to a variety of audiences. You will help us to raise awareness of our charity's work and impact, inspire people to support us, and share the voices and experiences of people who use our services.

### When / Where

A minimum of 4 hours per week volunteering on site at St Oswald's Hospice, Regent Avenue, Gosforth, Newcastle upon Tyne NE3 1EE

Plus a minimum of 4-5 hours per week training (195 hours in total) at Pitman Training Centre, 2 Collingwood Street, Newcastle upon Tyne NE1 1JF where you will be supported by the Pitman Training Staff.

### Main Tasks

- To help find, research and create case studies, stories and other marketing communications content for digital and print, in a range of formats (written, audio and video). This will include interviewing people in person/over the phone and writing compelling case studies/news stories/social posts to engage a range of audiences.
- Generate ideas for engaging social media campaigns and support the development of social media content across our channels including @stoswaldshospice, @stoswaldsretail @poshfrocksbystowalds



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- To assist with monitoring, analysing and the evaluation of communications and marketing activities.
- Help with proofreading and provide quality control for print and electronic publications.
- Undertake adhoc tasks as required.

### Skills and Experience

- High standard of written English as there is a strong writing element to this role with a minimum of grade 5 at GCSE level.
- Ideally experience of writing to engage a variety of audiences.
- High standard of spoken English as this role involves talking to and interviewing a range of people in person, on email or by phone (mainly staff, volunteers, patients and families, supporters).
