- Accepting donations from the general public
- Sorting donated stock and quality checking it
- Preparing stock for sale
- Researching stock e.g. via the internet or through local contacts
- Where appropriate pricing stock
- Creating attractive displays
- Help with moving of shop furniture
- Any other reasonable duties as requested by the shop manager

- Teamwork Volunteers work alongside staff and other volunteers, so being a reliable and cooperative team player helps keep things running smoothly.
- Customer Service Skills A friendly and approachable manner helps create a positive shopping experience and encourages sales and donations.
- Furniture roles often involve lifting, moving, and arranging heavy items, so being physically fit and able to handle manual tasks is essential.
