- Preparing and maintaining resources, equipment and clinic / treatment rooms.
- Supporting delivery of Lymphoedema treatment (including application / removal of bandages / compression garments, washing limbs and application of skin care, recording patient height, weight and limb measurements, talking to patients in clinic).
- Providing basic administrative support.
- Ensuring that infection control principles are demonstrated at all times including use of PPE.
