

Peter Rabbit™ Raffle - Terms and Conditions

These Terms and Conditions are the Raffle Rules. By entering the raffle, entrants agree to be bound by these rules.

Thank you for supporting the Peter Rabbit™ Raffle.

The closing date is midnight on Sunday 11th October 2026. The draw will take place on Tuesday 13th October 2026. Any money received after the closing date will be treated as a donation.

Please be aware:

1. Credit card payments will not be accepted online or over the phone.
2. This is an online raffle only. This means;
 - a. No physical tickets will be issued.
 - b. An email confirming tickets purchased will be sent immediately as proof of purchase.
 - c. Tickets can only be purchased via our website at the following address:

3. The draw will be made using an online random number generator to determine the three prize winners. The random number generator will be used to determine the winner of the prizes in order of first to third.
4. No tickets may be sold to under 16s and the maximum number of tickets which can be purchased is 200 per person. If any ticket/s are unknowingly sold to a person who is under the age of 16, they will be exempt from the raffle, they will forfeit their prize and their entry money will be returned to them.
5. All entries shall be priced at £5.
6. All raffle entry sales are final and no refunds shall be made at any time. All entrants acknowledge that their payment of £5 per ticket to enter the Peter Rabbit™ Raffle does not guarantee that they will win any prize.
7. Full payment for each ticket must be received in the form of cleared funds before the ticket can be entered into the draw. Only tickets for which full payment has been received in the form of cleared funds are eligible to win one of the prizes.
