JOB TITLE: Auxiliary Nurse

The Role

The Auxiliary Nurse, under the guidance and supervision of a Registered Nurse, provides holistic care to patients and families, ensuring a safe environment is maintained at all times.

Main Outcomes/Responsibilities

You will be responsible for delivering the following outcomes, with the direct supervision and support of the Registered Nurses and Leadership Team:

- Work under the supervision of a Registered Nurse to deliver personalised care.
- Conduct basic assessments (e.g. monitoring vital signs and performing urinalysis).
- Maintain and update accurate patient records.
- Report any abnormal findings to a Registered Nurse or medical practitioner.
- Responsible for cleaning, tidying and re-stocking clinical areas and carrying out daily checks on equipment e.g. oxygen
- Communicate effectively with patients, families, and the care team.
- Provide timely, accurate information while maintaining confidentiality.
- Work positively within a multidisciplinary team, including volunteers.
- Maintain good relationships with both internal and external healthcare professionals.
